



What is necessary for learning something in depth?



Three Pillars of Learning



Attention

- Students need to be paying attention to learn.
- What they pay attention to matters.
- What you pay attention to matters even more!
 - eye contact & facial expressions cues their brain to listen and engage.

Active Engagement

- Passive students aren't learning.
- Students need to constantly rephrase concepts in their own words.
- Maximize curiosity by tailoring problems to be difficult but not out of reach.

Error Feedback

- Students must be provided with quick and accurate feedback.
- This doesn't mean constant correction, but it does mean constant guidance.
- Never say that is right or wrong, ask questions to probe their understanding instead.
- Testing is an important tool for efficient learning.

Rebuilding Curiosity




Lecturing can often stifle curiosity.

What you can do as tutors:

- Pay extra attention to a student
- Give real time guidance by asking questions tailored to the students understanding
- Provide material/projects/tasks tailored to the students level

Rebuild the students confidence in their ability to learn new material!

Never say anything a student could say, have them say it instead!



Lecture as little as possible



Ask good



Give the students time to think and generate hypotheses.




Don't let students struggle
